



MICHAEL F. JOHNSTON

Michael Johnston is the former executive chairman of Visteon Corporation, having retired in November 2008. Johnston joined Visteon in September 2000 as chief operating officer and president and on June 28, 2004, was named chief executive officer and president. Johnston became chairman and CEO on June 1, 2005, a position he held until June 2008. Johnston served on Visteon's board of directors since April 2002.

Prior to joining Visteon, Johnston had been with Johnson Controls, Inc. since 1989 and held leadership positions including president of e-business; president, North America/Asia Pacific for Johnson Controls' Automotive Group; and vice president and general manager of Johnson Controls' automotive interiors and battery business.

Johnston also has experience in the aerospace industry, holding various managerial positions at Micropol, a subsidiary of Northwest Industries. Additionally, he serves on the board of directors for two Dallas, Texas-based companies, Flowserve Corporation and Quexco, as well as Whirlpool Corporation based in Benton Harbor, Michigan.

Johnston holds a bachelor's degree in industrial management from the University of Massachusetts at Lowell and a master's degree in business administration from Michigan State University's Executive Program.
